

## NORWAYNE FFA ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is given to a graduating senior on behalf of the Norwayne FFA Alumni Association. The scholarship deadline for applicants is March 1st of each year.

Scholarship Amount: The exact number of recipients each year and the exact scholarship amount will be determined by the amount of funds available for the scholarship and the number of qualified applicants as determined at the discretion of the Scholarship Selection Committee and the Norwayne FFA Alumni Association. The scholarship award shall be paid directly to the school or university and will be applied to tuition and/or books at the student's selected school.

**Eligibility Requirements:** Those eligible for the scholarship must be a graduating senior from Norwayne High School, Creston, Ohio who meet the following criteria:

- A senior pursuing a two or four year degree at an accredited school or university;
- A senior who will be continuing work in an Ag related business. This award could be used for training or monetary support to assist the student in pursuing their business venture. (Examples could include: QuickBooks class, pesticides training class, welding class, or some type of equipment to assist a student in a new ag related venture following high school graduation such as software, etc.). If choosing to apply for training or monetary support, please attach a statement of 500 words or less detailing this information.
- Must have maintained a 2.5 or higher GPA;
- The individual must have participated in FFA in high school, with preference given to those who have been highly involved in CDEs, SAEs, and chapter activities.
- Preference may be given for those continuing their education or work in an ag related field, depending on the applicants. It is not necessary that the applicant be entering an ag related field.

**Selection Committee**: The Scholarship(s) will be awarded by an appointed selection committee of the Norwayne FFA Alumni and will be based on the information provided on the application. A minimum of three (3) persons shall serve on the selection committee and any committee members shall excuse themselves if they have a child or close relative who is an applicant.
